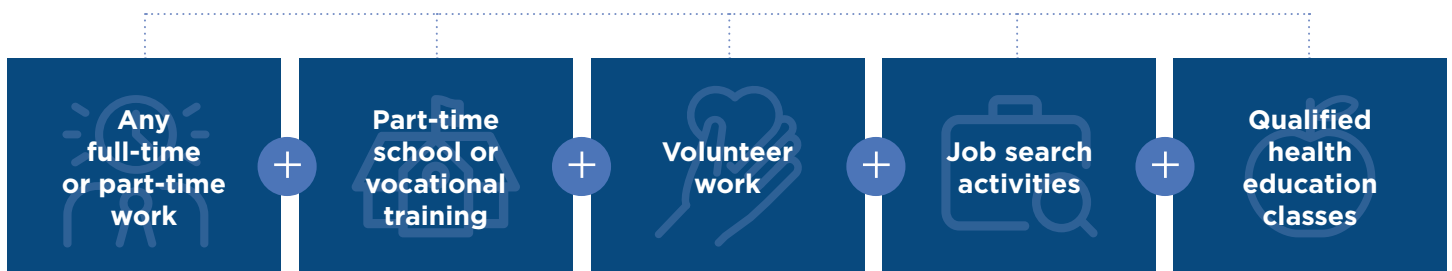


There are **NEW** requirements to keep your **ARKANSAS WORKS** coverage

Key Requirements:

- Now AR Works enrollees must report **80** hours of work activities monthly or risk losing benefits until the next calendar year.
- Reporting deadline is the **5th** of each month. | **EXAMPLE:**
Report June activity by July 5th
- There are exemptions for those unable to work. But you must still report!
- Report at www.access.arkansas.gov

These activities count toward the 80 hour-per-month work requirement:



IF YOU CANNOT WORK, YOU MUST REPORT YOUR EXEMPTION

Report online every **6** months if:

- You are receiving unemployment benefits
- You are in school or vocational training full-time

Report online every **2** months if:

- You are in a drug or alcohol treatment program
- You are incapacitated or caring for an incapacitated person

This is automatically checked, so you do **NOT** need to report:

- **If** you meet work requirements for SNAP or TEA.
- **If** you live in a household with dependent children, you are exempt until they reach age 19.
